

Easy Xmas Serviettes/Placemats



Step 1:

Source the pattern from the school office. It is literally a semi circle with a small box on one side. When it is folded over at the end, it will resemble an Xmas tree which will look fantastic for your table setting come Xmas.

Step 2:

Choose two different Xmas fabrics and cut out one pattern of each. Spotlight has many and if you purchase a fat quarter quilting size, you will get two sides of a tree per fat quarter. It is best if you cut the fabrics at the same time with the pattern/right sides facing each other.

Step 3:

Keep them together as you have cut them out and begin sewing them around the perimeter with a 1cm hem. Make sure to keep an opening of about 5cm so that you can turn them inside out and iron flat to show the Xmas fabric.



Step 4:

Once it is right sides facing out you can tuck in the edges of the box shape and either sew with the machine or hand sew them together.

Step 5:

Arrange in the folded shape and press firmly with an iron. This is what it should look like, from the pattern to the finished two



fabrics.
